GUTS TO GLORY stalked the pace, eased three wide leaving the turn, then rallied to take over at the eighth pole and drew away under urging. GRAVE stalked the pace along the inside, eased out and was attempting to split rivals when forced into LET'S CONNECT inside the eighth pole, steadied, then recovered, angled out and closed to prove best of the rest. BOLD DISTINCTION vied for the lead outside LET'S CONNECT, came out a bit leaving room for GRAVE in midstretch, then drifted in forcing that rival into LET'S CONNECT and tired. LET'S CONNECT vied for the lead along the inside, then was checked when bumped by GRAVE inside the eighth pole and faltered. AYRTON off slowly, saved ground and faded. PADDLEYOUROWNCANOE was outrun. KING KHALIFA broke slowly, then was chasing the pace three wide when pulled up on the turn and vanned off. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND FOUL CLAIMS BY THE RIDER OF LET'S CONNECT AGAINST THE RIDER OF GRAVE AND THE TRAINER OF LET'S CONNECT AGAINST THE RIDER OF BOLD DISTINCTION, BOLD DISTINCTION WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FOURTH FOR CAUSING INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH.
