EXCLUSIVE MOON showed speed off the rail, eased to the inside on the turn after clearing FORASTERO, then drew off through the stretch under urging. TIGER chased the pace off the rail around the turn but was no match for the winner in the drive while clearly best of the others. RICH INTENTIONS unhurried after being steadied when he ducked in at the start, passed tired rivals for the show. PEACEFUL PRINCE reserved racing along the inside, tired. FORASTERO pressed the pace along the rail into the turn, then couldn't stay with the winner and faltered. BEST OF was never a factor. CASHEL BACK was outrun while racing three wide. SORRENTO KID was never close after being steadied to avoid RICH INTENTIONS at the start. GOOD AND GRATEFUL chased the leaders off the rail, then steadied midway of the turn and faded.
