LILLY'SOFTHEFIELD rated off the pace, rallied three wide on the far turn to gain command at the quarter pole, then drew clear under urging. VENTUROUS LADY well placed while saving ground, eased around SOPHIE'S CROWN on the far turn, rallied to reach the attending position but didn't do enough late while holding the place. TACTFULLY ANN outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the show. PROSPECTIVE MISS unhurried early, angled to the outside in early stretch and found her best stride late. THIS IS CRAZY (AUS) rated off the pace, advanced into contention four wide around the far turn but couldn't sustain her bid. COMBAT SOLDIER raced three wide and failed to menace. RINGAROUNDAROSIE was not a factor. WEOKA chased the pace into the stretch and tired. SOPHIE'S CROWN sprinted to a clear lead along the rail, made the pace to the quarter pole, then faded.
