Footnotes

MOMENT OF SONG rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, bumped with IRISH WIND in early stretch and rallied to be up late. FALL IN LINE vied for the lead along the inside, edged away from SMUGGLER'S RUN in the stretch but couldn't hold off the winner late. IRISH WIND reserved early, angled out leaving the turn, bumped with MOMENT OF SONG in early stretch and closed to gain the show. HUNTING HILLBILLY off slowly, raced three wide around the turn and lacked a rally. SMUGGLER'S RUN vied for the lead outside FALL IN LINE into the stretch and tired. WALLY'S FAYGO showed some early foot and faltered. HIMDIDIT bumped with STATE OF REASON at the start and was not a factor. IMPERIALISM was outrun after breaking slowly. STATE OF REASON showed little after bumping with HIMDIDIT at the start.
