Footnotes

COQUINERIE unhurried early, rallied three wide to gain the lead on the far turn, was outmoved in the stretch, angled out and came on again under pressure to be just up at the wire. SILET rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, rallied to take over at the eighth pole and opened a clear lead, then just failed to last. SKIP COMMAND allowed to settle after being steadied in the early going, advanced four wide around the far turn to loom a threat in midstretch, then didn't do enough late. DUSTI'S TUNE reserved off the pace, was steadied in behind TUSCANY LIGHT on the far turn, then couldn't gain late. TUSCANY LIGHT chased the pace, was taken up when caught in tight quarters on the far turn and failed to recover. MAINE SONG chased the pace along the inside, was steadied when caught in behind the fading VICTORY SNIT on the far turn and tired. SHRIMP TEMPURA was no factor after being outrun early. VICTORY SNIT sprinted to a long lead along the rail, made the pace into the far turn and faded.
