BRASSIE PRINCE stalked the pace, was steadied in behind the leader on the backstretch, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to catch KIERNAN'S LEGACY inside the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. KIERNAN'S LEGACY pressed the pace three wide, moved to gain a slim lead in the stretch but was outgamed to the wire. GREAT VICTORIAN set the pace under pressure racing off the rail into the stretch, then tired. PLAYFUL PAL saved ground to no avail. SIPHON CITY pressed the early pace along the rail and faltered. KING MONGO raced three wide and faded.
