GAL HAS TO LIKE IT chased the pace, rallied to catch WINNINGISGOOD entering the stretch, then edged away under pressure. OUR MR. BUD tracked the leaders along the inside, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a mild rally to be up for the place. SALT WATER COWBOY tracked the pace three wide, made a run to reach the attending position in the stretch, then flattened out. STRAIGHT FAX unhurried early, improved his position without threatening. WINNINGISGOOD showed speed along the inside to nearing the top of the stretch, then tired. BROTHER PAT was not a factor.
