MY BEST CHINA set the pace off the rail, increased her advantage in midstretch, then remained clear to the wire under pressure. CHANTILLY G. stalked the pace off the rail into the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while clearly second best. BYLINE reserved racing along the inside into the stretch, had no response when asked. CONSOLACION SUR failed to menace. BLAKE'SLUCKYPENNY saved ground to no avail. BOOGIE WOOGIE rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and faltered. CIAO BELLISSIMA chased the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then faded. DIBS ON DEBBIE trailed and was pulled up when she lost contact with the field on the far turn.
