PERFECT TURN checked afetr breaking slowly, raced well back early, made a quick four wide move to take charge on the turn then dre off under a vigorous hand ride. MISS ABERDEEN raced in the middle of the pack, rallied four wide to reach contention on the turn and contined on well to hold the place. MICHEL'S ANGEL was unhurried early, rallied four wide on the turn then closed late from outside. ROCKABELLA dueled four wide for five furlongs and weakened. THAT'S REAL NICE failed to mount a serious rally while saving ground. TACTICAL GO GO dueled between horses along the backstretch and faded on the turn. PINNA rushed up along the rail to contest the early pace, battled inside for a half and faded. IT HAPPENS showed brief speed along the rail and gave way on the far turn.
