Footnotes

HANDS WAVERING rated off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, rallied to catch GIN PLEASE just inside the eighth pole, then drew clear. GIN PLEASE set the pace under pressure along the inside to the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner clearly best of the others. TRIPPENTY hit the gate at the start, pressed the pace outside GIN PLEASE to nearing the stretch, then tired. NAVARRE LIGHT pressed the pace into the turn and faltered. FROSTY DANCING failed to menace. UNDENIABLY CONNIE was not a factor. REDCARPETAFFAIR showed early foot along the inside and faded. GREEN GLEN was through early and eased in the stretch run.
