CUTIN THE TIMBER reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, then rallied under pressure to be just up at the wire. QUEEN'S KNIGHT rated off the pace, rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole, then just failed to last. SECRET ENTRY vied for the lead along the inside, drew clear racing into the stretch, then gave way in the final sixteenth. PRINCE HAZEEM failed to menace. GABLES LIGHT vied for the lead outside SECRET ENTRY to midway of the far turn, then tired. I'M DANCING TOO bumped with REBEL GOLD at the start, tracked the leaders along the inside to nearing the stretch, then faltered. REBEL GOLD was no factor after being checked when bumped by I'M DANCING TOO at the start. EL GATOR was done early.
