JACKWAGON pressed the pace outside HOPEFULLY LUCKY, gained a slim lead from that rival at the top of the stretch, then was all out to just last over CARLY'S REAL DEAL. The latter, stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside HOPEFULLY LUCKY in the stretch, then rallied to just miss. HOPEFULLY LUCKY set the pace along the inside, came out a bit when headed by JACKWAGON at the top of the stretch, then stayed with that rival to deep stretch and weakened. SHADOW RUNNER reserved off the pace, advanced around the far turn to reach contention but didn't do enough late. BAD NEWS CAPTAIN rated off the pace, saved ground and lacked a late response. PERSONAL PSYCHIC hopped at the start and failed to menace. SARAVA STAR stalked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. OUR REDEMPTION was not a factor.
