Footnotes

NAN'S ROSE vied for the lead along the inside, drew clear leaving the far turn and remained clear to the wire under pressure. WINNIEDAWHALE reserved early, raced three wide on the far turn, angled to the outside for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. MISS LIZZIE TISH rated off the pace, saved ground into the stretch and closed to gain the show. MARIA'S SUNSHINE allowed to settle, angled wide in early stretch and failed to threaten while improving her position. ICANSEECLEARLY tracked the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. LOVELY FORTUNE vied for the lead outside NAN'S ROSE, then was faltering when her rider lost his whip at the eighth pole. TECHNICAL QUESTION checked from tight quarters in the early going and was never a factor. TOP ACCOUNT QUEEN chased the pace along the inside for a half mile and faded. SKIP CLASS refused to break. There was a stewards inquiry into SKIP CLASS refusing. No action was taken.
