MZ'S DON ZULON quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the rail into the stretch, then drew away when asked. GULF RUCKUS steadied along the rail entering the first turn, tracked the leaders along inside, angled out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the place while unable to get to the winner. MASTER TASSEL chased the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. CALL FOR BACKUP failed to menace. ALMURAAD (IRE) rated off the pace, made a run four wide on the far turn to loom a threat, then tired in the drive. AFLEET MAGIC was never a factor. CLOUDS OF FALCON was caught in tight soon after the start and outrun. HEZANELITE chased the pace off the rail into the far turn, then faded.
