SHANAGOLDEN GIRL was bumped and steadied from between rivals soon after the start, rallied five wide around the turn to reach contention, then responded to pressure and wore down MONUMENTAL to be just up in the final strides. The latter, set the pace off the rail, increased her margin in midstretch, then just failed to last. HONEYMOONER chased the pace three wide, was outmoved in early stretch, angled outside SHANAGOLDEN GIRL and finished willingly. WHOSTHEBETTERHALF unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. SPECTACULAR DOVE bumped with SHANAGOLDEN GIRL soon after the start, chased the pace four wide into the stretch and tired. THE GLORIOUS MS S rated off the pace, steadied in traffic on the backstretch and failed to threaten. BROOK OF BELLES was not a factor. R. G. GEORGEANNE chased the pace along the rail and faltered. RED AS RAIN broke poorly when he hit the gate at the start, rushed up along the rail to reach contention, was checked several times leaving the backstretch and on the turn, then faded. TAKE THE STAGE bumped with SHANAGOLDEN GIRL in the early going and was outrun. FABI trailed after breaking slowly.
