SPIRIT OF THE SOUL bumped with VALORANDAPPEAL at the start, showed speed off the rail, increased her advantage on the turn and proved best under urging. VALORANDAPPEAL bumped between rivals at the start, chased the pace three wide around the turn and closed to prove second best while unable to gain on the winner. FOREVER LOVING chased the winner off the rail into the stretch and tired. NO BADGE tracked the pace, was staid in behind the leaders soon after entering the turn, angled in to save ground into the stretch, then had no late response. COMMIT ME failed to menace. INDIAN SUMMER GIRL allowed to settle, lacked a rally. SURVITA was outrun. LOUIES PRINCESS saved ground and faltered. BEA'S BIONDA bumped with VALORANDAPPEAL at the start, raced four wide on the turn and faded.
