Footnotes

PRESENTING MILADY rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, then rallied under pressure to be up late. CACHINNATED sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner while clearly best of the rest. BOOK THE BULLET unhurried early, rallied to gain the show while no threat to the top ones. MISS SANDI STORM chased the pace to inside the eighth pole, tired and drifted out through the final eighth. STARSHIP ELAINE tracked the pace three wide around the turn, then was forced wide by MISS SANDI STORM through the stretch while faltering. REGGAE LADY outrun early, bumped the rail entering the turn and was never a threat. LOOKSTOOGOOD tracked the pace along the inside around the turn, then faded. ITCHY TOES reserved after being steadied in the early going, checked along the inside on the turn and was not a factor.
