Footnotes

BEN'S TUNE showed speed along the inside, responded when challenged by AREAHOTLOVER, then just edged that rival to the wire after a stretch long duel. AREALHOTLOVER chased the pace, rallied to reach even terms for command leaving the turn, then dueled with BEN'S TUNE through the stretch and just missed. LADY CHARLEEN off a step slowly, chased the pace three wide around the turn, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones while saving the show. ANGEL OF HOPE rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and tired. SWEETSIE broke slowly, then steadied entering the turn, saved ground and never threatened. BEAUTIFUL INSIGHT well placed racing along the rail, faltered. ROVINA was not a factor. LADY BEST steadied from tight quarters after the start, raced four wide on the turn and was not a factor. PRETTY DINNER was outrun. PEARL'S UNBRIDLED broke a step slowly, then was outrun while racing five wide.
