BANDIT PRINCE chased the pace outside SHEIKH, moved up to engage that rival on the far turn, then dueled with that one to deep stretch and prevailed. SHEIKH set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged by BANDIT PRINCE, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and yielded. SINGING ROCK allowed to settle, saved ground into the stretch and closed with a belated rally for the show. VERISMO unhurried early, steadied and veered out to avoid MUSTFUHR on the backstretch, then finished willingly while being edged for the show. LARRY'S FORTY TWO outrun while saving ground, steadied to avoid MUSTFUHR on the backstretch and never threatened. SERAPI CAT rated off the pace, faded leaving the far turn. MUSTFUHR was tracking the pace when he broke down on the backstretch and was pulled up.
