Footnotes

TORO SANTO unhurried after stumbling at the start, rallied three wide around the far turn, moved to take over just inside the eighth pole, then ducked out late under left-handed urging and prevailed. VANISHING BUCK reserved early, rallied four wide around the far turn, made a run at TORO SANTO inside the eighth pole but was being edged to the wire when that rival ducked out. SAINT NICHOLAS stalked the pace three wide, moved to gain a slim lead at the top of the stretch, maintained that advantage to the eighth pole and was outfinished. GREEN BLUFF reserved off the pace, passed tired rivals in the drive. STACK THE DECK sprinted to a clear lead racing off the rail, made the pace to the top of the stretch, then tired. WAR COLLEGE stalked the pace into the stretch and faltered. EL WILDCAT was not a factor. BRILLIANT PASSAGE chased the pace into the far turn, then faded. REDMAD MAX steadied at the start, saved ground while racing in striking position into the far turn, then dropped back. FLIGHT TO FREEDOM was outrun. There was a stewards inquiry into the incident with the top ones in deep stretch. No action was taken.
