ACT FOOLISH off a step slowly, rallied three wide to take over leaving the turn and drew off under a vigorous hand ride. PARTYING chased the pace off the rail, then was no match for the winner in the drive while proving second best. REALLY ROYAL unhurried early, checked to avoid running up on a rival on the turn, angled four wide and closed to gain the show. SAME TUNE failed to menace. CRANSTONIAN showed speed along the inside, then tired in the stretch run. SPRING ANGEL swerved in at the start and was outrun. NETJET raced four wide and faltered.
