I CAT pressed the pace outside THURSDAY, took over from that rival midway of the turn, then drew off through the stretch under urging. BANK STATEMENT pressed the early pace along the rail, dropped back leaving the backstretch, eased out and split rivals leaving the turn to chase the winner but couldn't match strides with that rival while proving best of the rest. GAETANO T rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the turn to loom a threat, then gave way in the drive. THURSDAY set the pace under pressure along the rail to midway of the turn and tired. QUIQUINHO stalked the pace off the rail into the turn, then faltered. RUN WILKO RUN raced three wide and faded. GREAT WHITE was done early.
