DUEL TO THE END vied for the lead between horses and continued on with good courage to prove second best while no match for the winner. ALWAYS FREEZING vied for the lead along the rail, then tired in the drive. LEGITIMATE vied for the lead three wide to nearing the stretch and faltered. DIABLO'S DONNA was outrun. LETO'S BOBBIE was never a factor. CHAMPAGNE ON ICE trailed after breaking poorly.
