VEGAS ALARM set the pace three wide into the far turn, then drew well clear leaving the far turn and remained well clear to the wire under urging. GENTLE BREEZE LOLA unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn and closed to gain the place. YOUR SONG outrun early, passed tired rivals along the inside to be up for the show. WORTHY YOU rated after being caught in tight entering the first turn, advanced off the rail to reach the attending position in the stretch, then flattened out. NOREENA THE GREAT failed to menace. HEY WHITEY was outrun while racing four wide. SCOTTISH BUBBLY chased the winner three wide into the far turn and faltered. BAZARGAN chased the pace, angled to the rail racing down the backstretch, then faded entering the far turn.
