RUNYON HUMOR chased the pace along the rail, slipped through inside CHIPTease at the quarter pole to gain the lead, then drew off under urging. CHIPTease set the pace off the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then was no match for the winner while holding the place. SWEEPING VICTORY reserved early, passed tired rivals to be up for the show. WHEREINTHEWORLD rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. TAKE ADVANTAGE stalked the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. BAY OF WICKLOW was done early. ALL FOR THE TRIP stalked the pace four wide into the far turn, then faded and was pulled up nearing the finish.
