Footnotes

WROL UP set the pace under pressure along the inside, drew clear in midstretch, then was fully extended to just last over EL KIWI. The latter, unhurried early, raced three wide around the turn and rallied to just miss. BARRY'S IMAGE rated off the pace, advanced into contention four wide around the turn, then couldn't stay with the top ones while closing to be just up for the show. HOUR MAN chased the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way. BLING BANG chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. ROYAL APOLLO reserved racing along the inside, faltered. PUTY BOY was not a factor. EL COWBOY pressed the pace outside WROL UP to nearing the quarter pole, then faded. RUNNINGFORTHEMONEY trailed.
