TOP KITTEN rated off the pace, dropped back to last when steadied leaving the backstretch, angled out to race four wide around the turn, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole, then drew away. LUCKY TRIP vied for the lead outside MARIMAR LIGHT to inside the eighth pole, then was being outfinished when her rider altered course outside TOP KITTEN at the sixteenth pole and held the place. B L'S LUCKY APPEAL allowed to settle, advanced into contention three wide around the turn and closed to be up for the show. MARIMAR LIGHT vied for the lead, moved to the inside on the turn while continuing to contest the pace to past the eighth pole, then gave way. CARSONS REGAL LADY showed brief speed along the rail and tired. RED LIQUOR N' LACE reserved early, advanced into contention three wide around the turn, then was steadied at the top of the stretch and faltered. INDIAN SUMMER GIRL raced four wide and was done early. ALMOST TRUE showed early foot and faded. The rider of LUCKY TRIP lodged an objection against the rider of TOP KITTEN for alleged interference at the sixteenth pole. The claim of foul was not allowed.
