**Footnotes**

BONBONI chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the quarter pole, then drew off under urging. DOC GREEN allowed to settle, raced three wide around the turn and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. STOMP broke slowly, moved up quickly to vie for the lead along the rail, then gave way in the drive. GIMMEAWINKPOPPY unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. SOULFULLY rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and tired. BEAUZEN off slowly, was not a factor. FABULOUS TEXAS was unprepared for the start and broke well behind the field when he had his head over the bar into the next stall gate, then never threatened. EARLY AGAIN was done early. GLAMAM vied for the lead outside STOMP to the quarter pole, then faltered. BATCHELOR FLIGHT chased the pace off the rail into the turn, then had nothing left. BEHIND THE PEW saved ground and faded. Following a stewards inquiry, FABULOUS TEXAS was deemed to have received and unfair start and was declared a non-starter.
