R OBSESSION reserved early, rallied three wide around the far turn, moved to take over in the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. WINNOW chased the pace three wide, moved to take over on the far turn but couldn't stay with the winner in the final eighth while clearly second best. BLUESPEEDWHITELITE allowed to settle, passed tired rivals to gain the show. UMA NORMA rated in striking position off the pace, tired leaving the far turn. FORMAL FLAME steadied from tight quarters at the start and was not a factor. SILVER NINER vied for the lead outside MISS KENAI into the far turn and faltered. MISS KENAI vied for the lead along the inside into the far turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth. RUSSIAN NOTE up close early, raced four wide on the far turn, stopped and was eased in the stretch. I LOVE ESKIMOS showed nothing and was eased in the drive.
