Footnotes

BRASSIE PRINCE off slowly, moved up racing down the backstretch to chase the pace three wide, moved to gain the lead at the quarter pole and opened a clear advantage, then was fully extended to just last over JABBOK. The latter, prompted the pace outside VICTORIOUS ACT, was checked from between rivals at the quarter pole, recovered and came on again to just miss. EXCALIBUR reserved racing along the rail, rallied to be up for the show. GREAT VICTORIAN chased the pace, was steadied in traffic on the backstretch, angled out for the drive and finished willingly. VALUE DRIVER chased the pace along the inside, dropped back racing around the turn, angled out for the drive and closed some ground late. VICTORIOUS ACT showed speed along the inside to nearing the stretch, then gave way. The rider of JABBOK lodged an objection against the rider of BRASSIE PRINCE for alleged interference at the quarter pole. The claim of foul was not allowed.
