Footnotes

QUISTOPHER set the pace under pressure along the inside, drew clear on the far turn, responded when headed by FAIR WEATHER STAN in the stretch and came on again to prevail. FAIR WEATHER STAN outrun early, angled out and circled rivals four wide around the far turn, moved to gain a slim lead in the stretch but was outgamed to the wire. GRACE'S SPIRIT tracked the pace along the rail into the stretch and gave way. SERAPI CAT reserved early, made a run to reach the attending position on the far turn, then tired in the drive. RACHEL'S DANCER rated off the pace, advanced to reach contention on the far turn, then faltered in the drive. COIN IN THE SAND pressed the pace outside QUISTOPHER to the far turn, then faded and was eased in the final eighth. THREE ON A MATCH was outrun and eased in the stretch run.
