**Footnotes**

AMERICAN DOE rated off the pace, advanced along the inside around the far turn, rallied to catch SCORPION AL just inside the eighth pole, then edged away under urging. SCORPION AL vied for the lead outside STEDFAST CAT, took over from that rival nearing the quarter pole, then drifted out at the top of the stretch and couldn't stay with the winner in the final eighth while saving the place. BIG SCOOP was caught in tight at the start, stalked the pace three wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late while just missing the place. DREWNORMOUS unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn and improved his position. STEDFAST CAT vied for the lead along the rail to past midway of the far turn, then tired. FRANCIS MARION bumped hard with ULTIMATE CHOICE at the start, chased the pace off the rail into the far turn and faltered. ZEN IMPERIALISM was done early. TITLE TOWN well placed into the far turn while saving ground, faded. ULTIMATE CHOICE rated off the pace after bumping soundly with FRANCIS MARION at the start, made a run to reach contention midway of the far turn, then had nothing left.
