MUCHO MAS MACHO unhurried after breaking slowly, rallied four wide around the far turn, moved to take over approaching the eighth pole, then was fully extended to hold off GREAT SCOT. The latter, allowed to settle, advanced three wide around the far turn, then responded to pressure in the drive and was gaining on the winner at the finish. RULE NUMBER SIX rated off the pace, angled out in the stretch and finished willingly to be up for the show. AUSSI AUSTIN reserved off the pace, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch but had no further response. GIBSON COUNTY LINE pressed the pace outside GOSPEL IT TIZ, then bumped repeatedly with BUZZ THE DEPUTY approaching the eighth pole and gave way. PICO BOLIVAR raced four wide and failed to menace. CONCORDE EXPRESS stalked the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then was tiring when steadied avoiding traffic in the stretch. GOSPEL IT TIZ set the pace under pressure along the rail, then bumped hard several times with BUZZ THE DEPUTY approaching the eighth pole, stumbled and faded. BUZZ THE DEPUTY stalked the pace, was attempting to split rivals when he bounced off of both GIBSON COUNTY LINE and GOSPEL IT TIZ several times approaching the eighth pole, stumbled and unseated his rider. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE FALLEN RIDER. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
