**Footnotes**

NAVY WINGS rated off the pace, angled four wide on the far turn, rallied to gain a slim lead at the sixteenth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. WINNER JAK reserved off the pace, angled five wide on the far turn, rallied with NAVY WINGS through the stretch but was outgamed to the wire by that rival. MIMITO BOY moved up with SOUTHERN GLITTER on the backstretch to reach even terms for command, vied along the inside with that rival, opened a clear lead in the stretch, then gave way in the final sixteenth. GROVE HALL tracked the pace three wide into the stretch but had no late response. MEAN SAX stalked the pace, advanced to reach contention racing into the far turn, then weakened in the drive. SURELY SENT failed to menace. SOUTHERN GLITTER chased the pace, moved up with MIMITO BOY on the backstretch to vie for the lead outside that rival to the top of the stretch, then tired. UFFIZI set the early pace along the rail, then dropped back when steadied from tight quarters along the backstretch and faltered leaving the far turn. BEAR'S ROCKET was not a factor.
