BIG CITY CYN rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, rallied to gain the lead at the eighth pole, then drew off under urging. NITE AT THE MOVIES chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over leaving the turn, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then was no match for the winner while proving second best. EMMANUELA outrun after she dwelt at the start, swung out for the stretch run and closed to gain the show. DEVIL'S ENERGY tracked the pace along the inside around the turn and tired. MINIVAN tracked the pace, advanced three wide around the turn to loom a threat racing into the stretch, then faltered. WILDCATINJEANS showed speed along the rail to the quarter pole and faded. HERE'S TO HEAVEN reserved along the rail, steadied from tight quarters on the backstretch and dropped back. VERSAICE was no factor while racing three wide.
