CAPITALISM AT RISK showed speed off the rail, drew clear in the stretch, then was all out to just last over OH CAROLE. The latter, unhurried after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run, then drifted in a bit late while rallying to just miss. SAINT AGGIE chased the pace four wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. ANGELICA ZAPATA reserved off the pace, advanced along the rail around the turn but had no late response. BAHIA BEACH failed to menace. STARSHIP TRUFFLES tracked the leaders off the rail into the stretch and gave way. GIVHANS FERRY prompted the pace outside CAPITALISM AT RISK to nearing the stretch, then tired. LATIN ROCKS raced four wide and faded. THE RIDER OF SAINT AGGIE LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF OH CAROLE FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN LATE STRETCH. THE CLAIM OF FOUL WAS NOT ALLOWED.
