BLACK DIAMOND CAT stalked the pace, was steadied in behind the leaders on the turn, eased out four wide, then rallied to take over just inside the eighth pole and edged away. CLOSE IT OUT reserved early, saved ground into the stretch, then rallied under a strong hand ride for the place after his rider lost his whip inside the eighth pole. GRANDE SHORES rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, then closed with a mild response to be up for the show. BAHAMIAN SQUALL showed speed along the inside to the eighth pole, then weakened. JACKSON BEND rated off the pace, eased out for the stretch run and lacked a late response. TRICKMEISTER pressed the pace outside BAHAMIAN SQUALL into the stretch and gave way. ON APPEAL chased the pace, made a run three wide to join the leaders on the turn, was vying for the lead when his rider lost his whip at the top of the stretch, then tired in the final eighth. SMOKING THE FIELD well placed early, raced three wide around the turn and faltered.
