P. at the start, angled out for the stretch run and closed to prove second best while unable to stay with the winner. ANGELOFDISTINCTION reserved off the pace, passed tired rivals for the show. HELLO PRINCE vied for the lead along the inside to nearing the stretch, then tired. INDIRECTLY A. P. bumped with BAHAMIAN SQUALL at the start, vied for the lead outside HELLO PRINCE to nearing the stretch, then faded.
