**Footnotes**

BARTENDER chased the pace off the rail, rallied to take over at the sixteenth pole, then drew clear. INDY BY DESIGN reserved off the pace after breaking awkwardly, eased out for the stretch run and rallied to be just up for the place. DYNAMIC DUKE showed speed along the rail, opened a clear lead on the turn, made the pace to the sixteenth pole and gave way. COMMANDER BULL raced three wide and failed to menace. PAST GLORY chased the pace along the inside into the turn, then tired. PUT IT BACK TIGER raced four wide and faltered. DADDY AGAIN was outrun after breaking a step slowly.
