### Footnotes

LITTLE MISS ECHO chased the pace along the rail, moved to take over nearing the sixteenth pole and was fully extended to prevail. KENTUCKY JACLYN outrun after breaking in the air, advanced along the inside around the turn, angled out for the stretch run and was gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. ELIZABETHSWILDROSE bobbled at the start, showed speed racing off the rail to inside the eighth pole and weakened. PENTUPESKIMO reserved off the pace, drifted out at the top of the stretch, then gained some ground late. MISS DIABLO'S CAV outrun early, angled wide for the stretch run and failed to threaten. DISCO FEVER chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. URBANA LIGHT faltered while racing four wide. RUN TO WIN trailed after breaking slowly.
