MOUNTAIN TIGER rated off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, rallied to catch LADY LIMIT at the eighth pole and prevailed. LADY LIMIT chased the pace, moved to take over at the quarter pole but couldn't stay with the winner in the final eighth while clearly best of the others. POWERGIRL chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead on the turn, then tired in the drive. COLONY QUEEN failed to menace. SPANISH SPIRIT showed speed along the rail, then steadied midway of the turn and faltered. WIDOW TAPP off slowly, was not a factor. THATS OUR GIRL trailed. The rider of SPANISH SPIRIT lodged an objection against the rider of POWERGIRL for alleged interference on the turn. The claim of foul was not allowed.
