THE WACO KID rated off the pace, eased out in the stretch, then rallied between rivals in deep stretch to be up in time. OLIGARCH rank and steadied in the early going, sprinted to a clear lead along the rail, made the pace to deep stretch and just failed to last. MADNESS N' MAYHEM reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, then rallied along the outside to just miss the place. KRIS AND ME unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn and closed ground late without threatening. WILD REVENGE chased the pace along the rail into the stretch but had no late response. CALPULLEC failed to menace. TRULY DISTINCTIVE showed early foot along the inside and faltered. BRECON reared up unseating his rider prior to the start and following a stewards inquiry was declared a scratch with all monies being refunded.
