DISTINCT chased the leader three wide, moved to take over inside the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. EL TEIDE reserved early, swung to the outside entering the stretch and rallied to be up for the place. FLYING BIRDIE quickly sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, then gave way in the drive. VIDLOCITY unhurried after breaking slowly, passed tired rivals between horses in the stretch run. OPEN MINDED chased the pace four wide around the turn and tired. INDIGO MOON was not a factor. PREDESTINE showed early foot and faltered. NELSON'S LADY broke to the inside, was hustled into contention along the rail, then faded in the drive. DEPARTING SOUTH (ARG) was outrun after being bothered at the start. FORMAL STICK broke slowly and trailed.
