BAY STREET GAL made the pace racing off the rail, then drew off when set down for the drive. ASK ME AGAIN bumped with MAN I LOVE CLARE racing down the backstretch, angled three wide midway of the turn and closed to gain the place. QUONCHONTAUG unhurried early, swung very wide leaving the turn and closed to be up for the show. PRINCESS KAY chased the winner racing off the rail into the stretch and tired. MAN I LOVE CLARE reserved off the pace, bumped with ASK ME AGAIN racing down the backstretch, then bounced off DEVIL IN PINK several times and was never a threat. LEAH'S SILVERADO was never a factor after being outrun early. QUON chased the pace four wide and faded. DEVIL IN PINK rated off the pace, bounced off MAN I LOVE CLARE several times racing down the backstretch and faded. The rider of MAN I LOVE CLARE lodged an objection against the rider of ASK ME AGAIN for alleged interference racing down the backstretch. The claim of foul was not allowed.
