Footnotes

TAKING OVER set the pace under pressure racing off the rail, drew clear in early stretch and maintained his advantage to the wire under urging. STEPHEN'S TRICK rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and rallied to be up for the place. HONOURABLE FLAG chased the pace four wide, made a run midway of the turn to reach the leader, then gave way in the drive. GREAT VICTORIAN chased the pace three wide, made a run at the winner on the turn, then tired. DEPUTY DANCE failed to menace after breaking a step slowly. SWEEPING SILK pressed the pace along the inside into the turn and faltered. FREEDOM ISNT FREE off a step slowly, was outrun.
