GYPSY DOT vied for the lead outside COMBAT SOLDIER, angled to the inside after gaining a clear advantage on the backstretch, responded when challenged by that rival again on the far turn and into the stretch, then drew clear. COMBAT SOLDIER vied for the lead inside GYPSY DOT, eased outside that rival racing down the backstretch, came on again to try for the lead on the far turn and into the stretch, then was on match for the winner while just saving the place. KATHYHETRAININA well placed racing along the rail, closed with a mild rally to just miss the place. PRETTY COZZENE raced in striking position into the stretch and lacked a late response. UNHURRIED chased the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. LOST DANCE steadied along the inside on the first turn, then was not a factor when steadied inside the fallen rider in the stretch. REEL LASS was being outrun when checked to avoid the fallen rider in the stretch. FIESTA unhurried early, had angled to the outside when she jumped a spot, stumbled and unseated her rider in the stretch.
