MYSTERIOUS LIGHT tracked the speed, raced four wide on the far turn, assumed command turning for home and drew off while being kept to the task. EDITOR'S WILD NOTE unhurried early, improved her position in deep stretch to gain the place while no match for the winner. SIGN POST vied for the lead with MISS SANDI STORM while off the rail and gave way in the drive. PERFECT TURN bumped with WHOLELOTOFIMAGE at the start then steadied, rallied to within striking distance along the inside on the far turn and weakened in the stretch run. WHOLELOTOFIMAGE bumped with PERFECT TURN at the start, was well placed while four wide on the far turn then tired. CACHINNATED stumbled at the start, stalked the pace five wide around the far turn and faltered in the drive. MISS SANDI STORM vied for the lead outside SIGN POST, three wide on the far turn then faded in the stretch run. DEEPIINNEGOTIATIONS trailed.
