**Footnotes**

SERAPI CAT reserved racing along the rail, rallied and slipped through inside TRYING BRIAN to gain the lead approaching the eighth pole, then edged away. TRYING BRIAN vied for the lead along the inside, opened a clear lead on the far turn but couldn't stay with the winner in the final eighth while continuing on with good courage for the place. NORTHERN ACADEMY unhurried while saving ground, angled out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show while no threat to the top ones. BACK TO BACK JACKS allowed to settle, raced four wide around the far turn, was steadied at the top of the stretch, then improved his position. CAIXA ELETRONICA tracked the pace, advanced on the far turn to loom a threat entering the stretch, then tired. ECLIPSEONE was outrun. CHAZMULE was not a factor. BO'S SECRET STORM tracked the pace into the far turn, then faltered. CONCERTOS SONG vied for the lead to the far turn while racing well out in the course, then faded and was eased in the stretch run.
