Footnotes

BOB'S JAWBREAKER stalked the pace along the rail, moved through to gain the lead on the backstretch, responded when challenged by PRIME PRECISION racing into the stretch, then drew clear. PRIME PRECISION stalked the pace three wide, made a run to try the winner racing into the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival while proving second best. ASHLEE THE GREAT reserved early, advanced four wide around the far turn to loom a threat, then tired in the drive. BOND BARONESS off slowly, raced with the pace into the backstretch, eased back to stalk the leaders into the far turn, angled to the inside, then faltered. SILVER CHEST rated off the pace, was saving ground when steadied to avoid BOND BARONESS on the far turn and never threatened. RICH MARQUET set the early pace off the rail, stalked BOB'S JAWBREAKER to nearing the stretch after losing the advantage to that rival, then faded in the drive.
