**Footnotes**

SHADOW RUNNER tracked the pace, rallied to gain a slim lead leaving the far turn, then responded when challenged from both sides in the stretch and held on gamely to prevail. CARLY'S REAL DEAL rated off the pace, was caught in traffic entering the far turn, then was forced to work his way through traffic again in the stretch, made a run along the inside to reach the winner but was edged to the wire. JUPITER unhurried early, rallied four wide around the far turn, made a run to reach the winner in the stretch and hung. DUFFY JUNIOR chased the pace, made a run to gain a slim lead entering the far turn, maintained that advantage to nearing the top of the stretch, then gave way. BEA TOP QUALITY rank while rushing to a clear lead, made the pace to nearing the far turn, remained in contention into the stretch after losing the advantage, then tired in the drive. DONT MESWIT GOLDIE reserved early, made a run down the backstretch to reach contention, was caught in traffic on the far turn and faltered. BALTIMORE SAINT was not a factor. BLACK ANTILOPE allowed to settle, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention, then faded.
